On 15 July 2021, the national authorities of Germany, the Netherlands, Norway, Sweden and Denmark formally submitted their intention to prepare a restriction proposal on per- and polyfluorinated substances (PFAS) to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

In addition, we have published today brief summaries of the information we have gathered so far, as well as an accompanying questionnaire.

With this new consultation we would like to ensure that the information already available reflects the current market situation as closely as possible, and fill remaining data gaps.
