Dear Sir:

In March, 1972 I requested confirmation that you had discontinued the use of all Therminol® FR series heat transfer fluids in your plants. Since I received no response from you I have concluded that you have chosen to continue to use these fluids in your operations.

Recently the Food and Drug Administration published in the Federal Register a final rule making order regulating the presence of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) in establishments processing animal feed, food-packaging material and food. I have attached a copy for your use. As you know, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) are present in Therminol® FR fluids. *but not in other Therminol series*

It seems appropriate at this time to re-evaluate your decision to insure that your operations are in compliance with this new regulation.
