Continuation of Plaintiff Nevada Power Company's March 12, 1993 Notice of taking deposition of defendant Westinghouse Electric Corporation pursuant to FRCP 30(b)(6) except as to subtopic "8" (eight) of "Attachment A." Nevada Power and Westinghouse stipulate that Westinghouse reserves its right under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure to designate appropriate person or persons, and the parts of the notice to which those persons will respond, and that Nevada Power reserves its right to contest the adequacy of those designations. The parties contemplate that the deposition regarding topic "3" (three) of the notice would take place after the Court has had an opportunity to rule on Westinghouse's claim to privilege as to documents submitted in camera

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pursuant to Sections 4 and 5 of the Court's order of July 16, 1993.
