MUTUAL COOPERATION

The Sukarno-Kennedy communique read, in part:

"The two presidents discussed the recent emergence of the new nations in Asia and Africa. Both presidents welcomed the newly found freedom of these countries and agreed that their genuine aspirations can best be fulfilled through mutual cooperation both within and without the United Nations. Both presidents recognized that these new countries must be alert to any attempt to subvert their cherished freedom by means of imperialism in all its manifestations."

The message added that the two presidents "strongly and unreservedly support the goal of a neutral and independent Laos." It said they recognized that the disarmament problem must be solved and a treaty to end nuclear testing would be a "most significant step."

HOSPITAL SHIP

They noted the high degree of cooperation between Indonesia and the U.S. was manifested through the "successful visit to Indonesia of the hospital ship the SS Hope, sponsored by the people of the people Health Foundation."

While it was known that the two leaders had discussed means of avoiding a clash between Indonesia and the Netherlands over the territory of West Irian as the Indonesians call it, the communique was totally silent on this issue.

Small City Rise In Jobless Told

WASHINGTON, April 25 (AP)—April brought an increase in the number of smaller areas suffering from substantial unemployment, the government reported today.

The report led Secretary of Labor Arthur J. Goldberg to observe that "we are still not out of the woods" on the unemployment problem.

No change was reported in the number of major labor market areas listed as having substantial labor surplus—those with 6 per cent or more of their work force unemployed. That number remained at a record 101 out of the 450 areas surveyed.

The smaller areas added to the substantial unemployment category include Danbury and Willimantic, Conn.; Cedar-Rockmart and Toccoa, Ga.; Danville and Kankakee, Ill.; Kokomo, Ind.; Alexandria, La.; Newton, N.J.; Forest City-Rutherford, N.C.; Marion, Ohio; Klamath Falls, Ore.; Centralia, Wash.; and Oskosh and West Bend, Wis.

The bill also makes it clear the provisions apply to planning commissions, library boards, recreation commissions and other permanent boards or commissions of a local agency, as well as the regular government bodies.

Carrier Strength of 6th Fleet Cut

WASHINGTON, April 25 (AP)—The Defense Department has decided to cut the number of U.S. aircraft carriers in the Mediterranean from three to two ships and has ordered the carrier Shangri-La back to Mayport, Fla. ahead of schedule.

The action in effect reverses Eisenhower administration plans to put into effect last August. Former President Eisenhower ordered the 6th Fleet buildup after the U-2 incident—the Paris summit conference blowup and Democratic demands for strengthening defenses.

Navy officials said the 6th Fleet now will revert to its normal practice of operating two carriers. There was no indication whether the cut resulted from the Cuban crisis in the Western Hemisphere.

No official explanation was given for the change in policy, which apparently reduced 6th Fleet air strength by about one-third. Each carrier can handle 75 to 100 planes.

First word of the decision to cut back the Mediterranean force was contained in a sketchy news release issued by the Atlantic Fleet in Norfolk, Va., during the week.

U.S., Russia Row Anew On Cuba In U.N.
