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From time to time I have made reference to certain materials listed in the Federal Register, Volume 20, No. 121 (Part II), 23 June 1975. This list comprises materials which have reportedly produced an observed or suspected carcinogenic response in animals based upon published articles in the literature. This list is composed of materials reported to cause benign or malignant tumors. The list covers 106 pages and it is possible in the following that I have omitted some which may be of interest to the Chemicals Group.

Some of the following materials have been used as analytical reagents while others have been incorporated in our manufacture or potential chemical manufacture and in finished products of the Chemicals Group as well.
