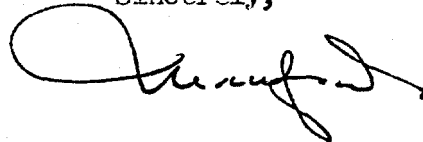

Dear Manfred:

I have just returned from the West Coast where I did a bit of discreet looking into and talking about certain aspects of the problem of air pollution in Los Angeles. Despite the talks of one Chandler Phillips on the importance of lead in the situation, I did not encounter much apprehension about it. There are, I think, some steps to be taken to make reasonably sure that some person (or persons) in a responsible position does not go off the deep end for lack of information, but beyond that I am not much concerned.

Certain of the reports mentioned in your letter of February 16 would be of interest to me, specifically items 1 and 2. If you could let me see these, I'd appreciate it very much. I am not interested in the statements of Dr. Mills, and I'm not much interested in those of others about him. It seems quite unlikely to me that his views or activities will have much affect.

I had a very busy time in both San Francisco and Los Angeles, and also a very pleasant time. If I had had more time, I could have seen more of my friends, but I did see a number of them.

Thanks for your information, and in advance, for anything you can supply me with.
