Mr. Fisher and Mr. Brown were very pleased to learn that the interview report you are preparing for publication is bearing final form and is expected to be in the hands of the publisher within the next few weeks. The question as to date of publication is continually being raised by the underwriting companies; and I am sure they, as well as we, are pleased that this report is soon to be published.

I've shown us the finished report and said that certain pictures and a bit of condensation of sections were still needed but that otherwise it was ready to go. Inasmuch as I am passing out this information that publication can be expected soon, please let us know if the report will not be in the hands of the printers by the first of September, which would be about two months from the time you and I discussed this at the end of June.

A number of these companies feel that the publication of this information is very vital to them, since they have cases where the decisions could be materially affected by the results of this study. We should all regret very much any delay in the publication of the report.
