fixing its capital stock at \$1,000,000, divided into \$100 shares, of which amount \$20,000 has been subscribed by the directors, M. B. Hook holding 198 shares. The term of existence is fifty years. The railroad which the company intends to construct will be a single or double track, to be operated by steam or electricity, or both, between Los Angeles and San Pedro, and will have an estimated length of twenty miles. The directors are E. M. Milliken, H. V. Davis, Thomas J. Hook, M. B. Hook and W. H. Hook, all residents of this city. H. V. Davis has been elected treasurer of the corporation, and already 10 per cent., or 1200, of the capital stock subscribed has been paid into the treasury.

The other company just incorporated is the Los Angeles-Pasadena Traction Company, organized for fifty years, which proposes to construct a line from this city to Pasadena, an estimated distance of ten miles. The directors are as in the above company, E. M. Milliken, H. V. Davis, Thomas J. Hook, M. B. Hook and W. H. Hook, all of Los Angeles. The capital stock is \$750,000, divided into \$100 shares, of which amount \$10,000 has been subscribed. M. B. Hook holds ninety-six shares. Davis is also the treasurer of this company, and 10 per cent. of the subscribed stock has been paid up in evidence of good faith.
