ALL EMPLOYEES

ON A RECENT VISIT TO THE TYLER PLANT BY H. CLARK UNDERWOOD, MANAGER OF SAFETY AND PLANT PROTECTION, HE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED A GENERAL, PLANT-WIDE EYE PROTECTION SAFETY PROGRAM, AND MANAGEMENT AT HIGHER LEVELS AGREED TO THE PROGRAM. THEREFORE, EFFECTIVE MONDAY, DECEMBER 8, 1969, ALL PERSONNEL WILL BEGIN TO WEAR APPROVED EYE PROTECTION SAFETY EQUIPMENT.

THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE NOT BEEN ISSUED SAFETY GLASSES WILL RECEIVE SAFETY GLASSES NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, DECEMBER 5, 1969.

PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT EACH EMPLOYEE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS OWN EQUIPMENT, AND FOR THE COST OF REPLACEMENT IF IT IS LOST OR MISPLACED.
