ORDER DENYING CONSIDERATION OF MOTION OF GARLOCK, INC. FOR STAY
ACCOMPANIED BY A REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

On this day came on to be considered Defendant Garlock Inc.'s (the "Defendant") Motion for Stay Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 8(a)(1) Pending Appeal Accompanied by a Request for Expedited Consideration.
