These photos taken August 8, 1968 illustrate progress over the past five working days:

Photo 1: Looking southeast shows progress on the roofing of the east side of the warehouse. Also visible behind and to the left of the trailer is the forming for the concrete ramp for fork truck access.

Photo 2: Looking north from the third floor of Building 28, progress on the roofing is quite evident. The last bay was actually covered today 8/9. The transformer shown in the lower left was energized on 8/8. It is a temporary installation pending shipment of the transformer originally ordered from H. K. Porter.

Photo 3: Looks northwest - progress in this area has been confined to tracing of pipe lines, minor changes before start-up and cleaning of tank interiors. Insulation is only partially finished, as you can see. The insulators are on strike. Lack of insulation will not prevent handling 1242 in the tank farm.
