A meeting was held in Sarnia on May 25 for the purpose of discussing the overall subject of TML in Canada. In addition to the members of our Operating Committee, Drs. Warren and Houston were also in attendance.

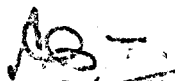
In summary, Dr. Warren reminded us that he had contacted the health authorities in British Columbia for the purpose of clearing the way for Standard of B.C. who planned to and now are distributing gasolines containing TML. He also advised the Chief of Occupational Health Division, Department of National Health and Welfare, Ottawa, concerning the same subject. Neither health group raised any objections.

It was decided that we should proceed with advising the industrial health authorities in the other nine provinces, even though the distribution of gasoline containing TML might be remote. This move would help us maintain a now satisfactorily established relationship with these people, would continue our reputation as the leaders in antiknock compound distribution in Canada, and would, to a degree, help us maintain our position of leadership with respect to competition. It was explained that none of these contacts would in any way violate the agreement which our parent company had signed.

The contacts mentioned in the foregoing will be handled by Dr. Warren.

The details of my letter of May 13 governing the control of distributing copies of the TML medical report prepared by Dr. Kehoe were reviewed for the benefit of the Committee, and all parties are in full knowledge of our policy.
