**WASHINGTON, D.C.** (July 12, 2017) Today, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrator Scott Pruitt applauded the U.S. Senate Environment and Public Works (EPW) Committee's vote in favor of Susan Bodine, nominee to be assistant administrator of the Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA) at EPA.
