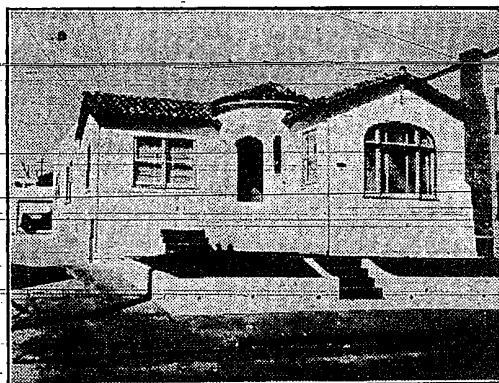

The exterior of the house is finished in white stucco with light green trim and tile roof. The interior is in plaster with oak floors throughout.

Opening off a reception hall is the large living room with artistic plaster fireplace. Three bedrooms, opening off a central hall, are exceptionally roomy and feature built-in wardrobes with storage drawers below.

The bath is full tile in light Persian brown with fixtures to match. There is a stall shower as well as a recessed tub.

Of particular interest is the large kitchen, bright with light and of sufficient proportions to allow for a full sized dining table. The many cupboards with glass doors permit artistic arrangement of the dishware. There is a full tile sink and work counter.
