In my letter to you of March 28th I asked whether it would be possible for us to get a complete copy of all the proposed new specifications for the Pyranols that we produce for General Electric Company. This will become more important to us in view of the fact that we anticipate greatly increased production of our Pyranol grade Arcelor at Anniston.

Our Anniston Control Laboratory has also requested my obtaining complete copies of all the present G.E. analytical methods for Pyranols. If you have an extra copy we will greatly appreciate having it for otherwise we will have to copy and photostat all of the methods now on file at Plant B.
