Dear Mr. Lansdale:

After careful consideration of our problem of distribution of replacement universal joints, and parts thereof, we have decided to adopt the following selling policies, as of March 1, 1948:

1. We will continue our arrangement with N.A.P.A. exactly as it has prevailed for the past twenty odd years, except that it will not be exclusive.
2. We will make a similar arrangement with certain concerns known as "Joint Specialists."
3. The same scale of discounts and distribution privileges will extend to the so-called "Joint Specialists" as to N.A.P.A. Namely:

60% Discount with a 20% override commission on jobber sales.
4. We will continue to cooperate with all N.A.P.A. distributing points to build up their distribution of Spicer joints and parts, and will, to the best of our ability, control the appointment of new jobber outlets so as to prevent an excessive number of these outlets in any given community.
