12 represents and what the whole chart represents is low
13 exposure levels.

14 All of these studies talk about low exposure
15 levels. That is why the chart is important in its
16 totality.

17 And Dr. Wong actually testified about this
18 point as well. He told you that as an epidemiologist
19 he has actually compared the exposure levels from one
20 job to the next, and I think he told you that some
21 jobs, like shipyard workers, have exposure levels on a
