Health and hygiene services

Departments or boards of health and in-
dustrial hygiene services are integral parts of
the organization of each of the states, the Dis-
trict of Columbia, and the autonomous terri-
tories of the United States

It is to these organizations that the safety
professional must look for his state's specific
standards and recommendations on such
points as occupational health, food and health
engineering, disease control, water pollution,
and other facets of the overall field of plant
hygiene

Industrial hygiene units usually function
full time or, in several states, on a limited
basis. In addition to the units that operate
under state health departments, a number of
other industrial hygiene units are run by
municipalities or other local authorities

In addition to direct industrial hygiene
services, these state units are able to bring
to industry a more or less complete health
program by integrating their work with that
of other divisions in the state government,
such as sanitation and infectious disease
control
