Item 13381 - RAW MATERIALS

Hansa Colors - Mr. Hennig is to work through Mr. Goldberg in an effort to have Hansa Colors, used for lend-lease material, placed on a quota-free basis. Has this been done? ✓

Item 13386 - OUTSIDE PURCHASES

Dr. Van Stone authorized to buy up to 400,000 gallons of Rx #471 and #450; also additional quantities of Flat Wall Paint, One-Coat Enamel, Primer and Sealer, and Enamel Undercoater. What progress has been made?

Item 13387 - SALES QUOTAS - KEM-TONE vs TRADE SALES OIL-BEARING PRODUCTS

Sales Department to consider a plan whereby Districts obtaining sales increases on Kem-Tone products receive a larger percentage of available Trade Sales goods.

Item 13388 - WAREHOUSE ASSISTANCE - SEPTEMBER

Mr. Lemperly to give consideration to having representatives assist in warehouses during early weeks of September.

Item 13390 - SHERWIN-WILLIAMS TURPENTINE

Sales Department recommends that our stock of Boston Round bottles be used for Turpentine. No decision made as yet.

Item 13394 - LEAD AND OIL

Mr. Rathbun to report on effort to secure 1/4¢ per pound increase in price.
