

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 24 (AP)—An irregular tone was noticeable throughout the list on the San Francisco Stock Exchange this morning, with trading running very light.

In the banking section Bank of Italy was quiet around 200 1/4. Bancitaly Corporation was steady at 120 1/8. American Company held even at 145. Among the industrials Byron Jackson Pump was strong, lifting on a small volume from 96 1/2 to 98 1/2. Caterpillar ranged from 81 1/2 to 80 1/2. Golden State Milk was lower at 60. Kolster was up fractionally, selling from 72 1/2 to 72 3/4. Piggly Wiggly rose from 34 to 34 1/2.

In the oils, Standard of California was steady, ranging from 63 to 62 3/4. Union Associates sold at 54 1/2, and Union Oil of California declined from 55 to 53 3/4. Shell Union was higher, lifting from 29 to 29 3/4.

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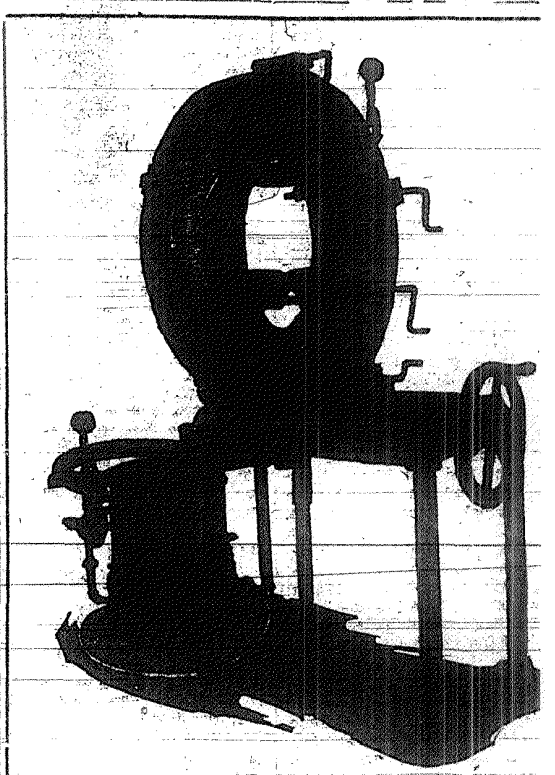
