Subject Advance Copy - Asbestos Exposure - Brake Repair

Attached is a copy of the page proofs of an article that will appear in the August 1976 issue of Environment Research. This is the first major study published that deals with employee exposure to asbestos during brake lining maintenance and repair.

The study indicates that it is conceivable to have asbestos levels in excess of OSHA standards up to 75 feet away from a brake reline job particularly if compressed air is used to remove dust from the drum and backing plate.
