5 Asbestos-free Kaylo.

6 Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corporation has for
7 many years marketed under the trademark Kaylo a
8 calcium silicate asbestos-containing high temperature
9 insulation product.

10 During the manufacturing and installation of
11 Kaylo products, airborne concentrations of asbestos-
12 containing dusts are generated.

13 Overexposure to airborne asbestos dust for a
14 long period of time is known to cause a fibrosis of
15 the lungs called asbestosis.

16 Often this overexposure may not be
17 subjectively offensive to the worker. It usually
18 takes from 10 to 20 years for the first objective
19 clinical sign of asbestosis to appear.

20 Irreversible and progressive lung scarring
21 will, therefore, occur in overexposed workers before
