We have found that we cannot measure phthalic anhydride in the samples that you collected in dichloromethane on 1-21-76. (Our Log #28.) Further work indicates that dichloromethane is not satisfactory as a solvent for this material and that future sampling for phthalic anhydride should be carried out in alcohol as in the past.
