WHEN: Prior to servicing rim tires and as necessary to maintain proficiency (i.e. annually).

WHO: All fork truck operators.

WHAT: Georgia Gulf Forktruck Training Module

WHEN: Initially before operating trucks.

Estimated Time-1 1/2 Hours Initially Only.

VCM

WHO: Each employee working in VCM or PVC units.

WHAT:

- A. Nature of health hazard from chronic exposure to vinyl chloride including specifically the carcinogenic hazard.
- B. The specific nature of operations which could result in exposure to vinyl chloride in excess of the permissible limit and necessary of protective steps.
- C. The purpose for, proper use, and limitations of respiratory protective devices.
- D. The fire hazard and acute toxicity of vinyl chloride and necessary protective steps.

WHAT: (CONTINUED)

- E. The purpose for and description of the monitoring program.
- F. Purpose for and description of the medical surveillance program.
- G. Emergency procedure.
- H. Specific information to aid the employee in recognition of conditions which may result in release of vinyl chloride and the review of this standard at the employees first training and indoctrination program and annually thereafter.

WHEN: Initially and Annually

Estimated Time/Year - 1 Hour.

WHO: All Asbestos Workers

- B. Cell renewal personnel of Master Maintenance.
