United Utilities	1	One raw water site had a sample with a concentration above the guideline value of 0.1 µg/l for perfluorooctanoic acid. This was at a point which is subsequently blended and receives treatment. A statutory notice under regulation 27(4) Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 2016 was served to ensure the company carries out a risk assessment. This was completed in May 2022 and continues to be reviewed and updated periodically as per the regulatory requirements. Investigations are ongoing to determine the raw water source or sources. There have been no final water detection exceeding the PFAS threshold.
