The only time you need this Primer when using LUCITE House Paint is over staining bare woods such as redwood, cedar or mahogany siding and fir plywood. Staining of redwood, cedar, mahogany and fir plywood is a function of the wood itself rather than the paint applied and consequently, complete freedom from staining cannot be assured. However, when 51 Primer and LUCITE House Paint are used according to instructions, discoloration and staining will be minimized and the finished finish will be extremely resistant to weathering, cracking, and peeling.

DIRECTIONS

Shedule behind any paint film may cause blistering and peeling. Be sure to check your house carefully; sand cracks, lead, scale of wood, etc. to prevent the entrance of moisture. Surfaces must be clean. When using LUCITE House Paint, the primer is only required over unpainted redwood, cedar, mahogany or fir plywood. For best results use two coats. Repeat monthly after 1 hour. All holes and other surface imperfections should be caulked or patched. Seal knots and sap streaks with a thin coat of sealer.

Application: Stir thoroughly. Apply by brush or roller. If staining is required, use water, say, to wet and get better. Avoid painting over a surface which is below 50°F, or exposed to reach the temperature above 1 hour. DO NOT TINT.

CARETAKING: Caution! Keep and store away from children. Handle with care. Do not apply on fire, furniture, or other interior surfaces which may be damaged by children. Avoid prolonged contact with skin and breathing of spray mist. Once weather after each use. KEEP FROM CHILDREN.
