SUBJECT: Industrial Dentists' participation in 1945 meeting

We are glad that the American Association of Industrial Dentists have decided to join the other groups interested in the industrial medicine specialty in our next annual meeting, - April 25-28, 1945, at the Drake Hotel in Chicago.

Dr. Ernest Goldhorn, who has been appointed as the Program Chairman for the Industrial Dentists, has suggested that Wednesday, April 25, would be the best day for them to schedule their own sessions, since that is a free day for their dentists and more men would be able to attend. This has already been taken care of with the Governmental Industrial Hygienists, since Dr. Heacock has been invited to present a paper on dental health at one of their sessions.
