Yesterday I spoke with Jim Barter, from the Chem Group's Environmental, Health, and Safety Department regarding the upcoming furnace rebuild. After discussions with Ron Williams from Lake Charles, Jim advised me that physicals for respiratory function will be required for all personnel entering the restricted work site. This would include a respirator fit test, which must be signed by a physician.

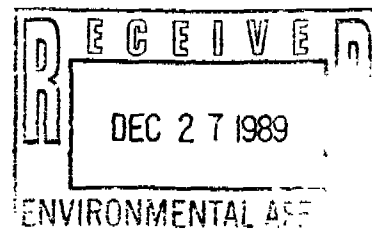
Please include this requirement in the contractor bid package that you are preparing for the job.

Also, I have been advised by Loren Anderson, also from the Chem Group's Environmental, Health, and Safety Department, that OSHA standard 1910.120 does not apply to our rebuild, but only to individuals working in hazardous waste facilities or emergency response teams associated with such wastes. This is consistent with the Glass Group's practices on rebuilds.
