

Below is a list of employees of Walter Nugent involved in either the tank cleaning operations or the pouring of the concrete or in some instances as noted both operations.

- 9 [REDACTED] (contractor) - both operations and was in and out of tank at various times during each procedure. Has had no complaints or symptoms and has been well. According to one of the workman he did some work but most of the time supervised.
- 7 [REDACTED] - was never in the tank during either operation
- 6 [REDACTED] - Turned the crank on the blower and was not in the tank during the cleaning procedure. However, he worked a considerable portion of the time in the tank during the pouring of concrete but was outside at times. He became ill and was hospitalized and is recovering satisfactorily.
- 3 [REDACTED] - worked during the pouring of concrete and worked in tank practically entire day. He leveled concrete on bottom and worked hard. He became ill at noon and continued to work remainder of the day. Was hospitalized following day, became maniacal and died one week after exposure.
- 4 [REDACTED] - worked during pouring of concrete. Helping inside of tank with concrete - also outside part of the time. Became ill following day, - was hospitalized and is recovering satisfactorily.
- 8 [REDACTED] - helped clean the tank, working at that time one day. Later helped with pouring of concrete, working in tank for half a day - felt ill at noon and worked outside of tank remainder of the day. Was in the hospital for one day and discharged. Condition satisfactory.
- 11 [REDACTED] - helped with concreting tank bottom, out of tank most of time. No symptoms or complaints at any time.
- 2 [REDACTED] - Turned crank of air pump during cleaning of tank - worked in but mostly out of tank pouring concrete.
- 10 [REDACTED] - Turned crank of air pump during cleaning tank - worked in but mostly out of tank.
- 5 [REDACTED] - Turned crank of air pump during cleaning of tank - worked in but mostly out of tank

- / [REDACTED] - Felt badly for one day.
- /3 [REDACTED] - Had not been heard from after last day's work - supposedly was well and had gone on visit.

[REDACTED] and son helped clean the tank but quit work at end of first day.

The above group of Mexicans worked much of the time outside of the tank, shoveling and handling gravel, cement, and operating mixer. Some complained of inability of sleeping and of being nervous the first night but reported well in a day or two and when I arrived most of them had called the contractor wanting to go to work and feeling well.
