Dear Mr. Offutt:

In accordance with the arrangements we made when I met you in Dr. Lanza's office, I am sending you the Memorandum of Agreement between certain members of the asbestos industry regarding the underwriting by them of the experiments with asbestos dust which Dr. Gardner is undertaking on their behalf.

The substance of the arrangement between the underwriting group and Dr. Gardner is contained in the exchange of letters between me and him, copies of which are in the hands of your attorney, Mr. Price, unless he has already delivered them to you.
