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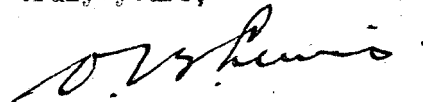

Replying to your letter of Aug. 8th, above subject and file.

[REDACTED] is the name of the man with lead poison or being very similar to it. He is out of town today. [REDACTED] was not able to see him and get his doctors name, but to come in Tampa after his local doctor failed.

[REDACTED] want you to thoroughly understand that he is not trying to hold anyone responsible for his condition. [REDACTED] does not want you to feel that he is trying to get anything out of the company. We thought as the company used a great deal of lead of one kind and another they would have some remedy in case of poison.

[REDACTED] is a painter and realizes that it is possible for him to get lead poison in a number of ways. While he uses our gasoline exclusively he does not blame his condition on the gasoline but as stated above he does not blame anyone.

Your letter of August 25th addressed to Mr. J. C. Taylor was turned over to me for handling.

In cases of alleged lead poisoning, we like to have the facts as nearly as they can be developed on each and every case that seems to warrant any suspicion. In the present case, that of the painter who is suffering from skin trouble, I believe if you could let us know the man's name and as many details as possible, together with the doctor's name that attended him, our Mr. Kehoe would probably be able to write a letter to the attending physician which would satisfactorily clear up the case. In more serious cases, of course, one of our doctors will attend in person if it is deemed advisable.

I will be so good as to continue to forward any information on cases of this nature, we will be glad to take care of same.
