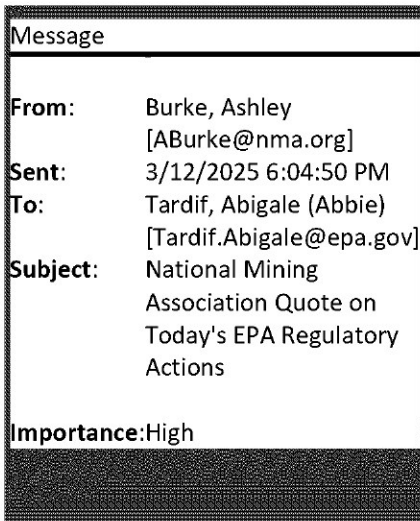

Rich Nolan, President and CEO, National Mining Association: "The reliability alarms are blaring as power demand growth from AI and data centers is colliding with eroding generation; until now, our energy policy has turned a blind eye to that reality.
