This was a very minor breach 151.6 mg/l (limit 150 mg/l) and brought to my attention today. This exceedance was due to the required cleaning frequency of the sampling pipework being exceeded. We will ensure additional training is provided to ensure the required maintenance (cleaning) can progress every 2 weeks.
