

The WIPED STENCIL Over Tiffany

*... a new and artistic stencil
treatment for use with the rich,
blended Tiffany finish.*

AN interior decorated in the Tiffany finish has a richness and charm obtainable in no other way. The soft, blended coloring of this finish—its spontaneous beauty—has an irresistible appeal. The Tiffany makes a dwelling much more desirable to the prospective purchaser.

Sometimes an effective touch of stenciling may be added to the Tiffany. This can be done most artistically by employing what is known as the Wiped Stencil treatment.

The border shown is an example of the Wiped Stencil. It is easily produced—simply wiped out through the openings of the stencil while the Tiffany top coat is still wet. The paint may be wiped out clean—showing the stencil design in the ground color. Or the paint may be wiped only lightly, producing a faint, somewhat indistinct design. Another interesting treatment is produced by tamping one or more colors through the stencil openings, after wiping out the paint as explained.

Suggestions for using this finish

The Wiped Stencil, used with the Tiffany, is effective in the entrance hall of the home, in the living room and in the dining room. The stenciling may be in the form of a frieze, or it may serve as a border for Tiffany panels.

In using the Wiped Stencil treatment, and

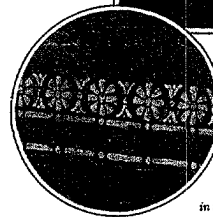
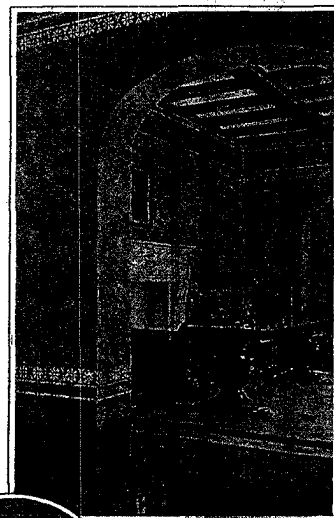
