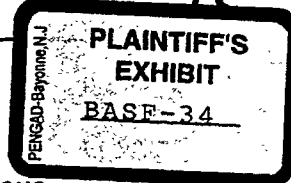

1.5 Safety Requirements:

The Contractor shall comply with BASF Wyandotte's Safety Standard 100.10.2 "General Rules for Contractors" as amended by this section. These rules shall be reviewed with BWC Safety Engineer and the Contractor before starting his work.

- 1.5.1 Technical Standard 100.10.2 "General Rules for Contractors" is amended as follows:

Medical

The word "dispensary" is intended to mean the following: Contractor shall have at least one employee on the job who holds a valid certificate in First-Aid training from the U.S. Bureau of Mines, the American Red Cross or equivalent training organization and Contractor will furnish all necessary supplies and equipment for First Aid Treatment. All others remain the same.

- 1.5.2 It shall be a primary goal of all parties associated with this project to provide a safe working environment. All contractors and subcontractors will comply with all Federal and State laws and ordinances relating to safety, including, but not limited to "OSHA" requirements and to conform with the provisions of the "Manual of Accident Prevention in Construction" published by the Associated General Contractors of America, Inc.

- 1.5.3 It will be the sole responsibility of the CONTRACTOR to establish and maintain a safety program.

- 1.5.4 The Contractor shall furnish all BWC approved equipment as required, including but not limited to:

1. Hard hats - non metallic
2. Safety glasses
3. Respirators - Scott Cat. No. 7D-DA disposable escape respirators
4. Soft side goggles - American Optical #499 BAF clear durafon lens

- 1.5.5 BASF Wyandotte Corporation shall be permitted to enter all areas of the construction site to inspect and investigate any work place, structure, procedures, operation, machinery, equipment or materials.

- 1.5.6 BASF Wyandotte Corporation's Safety and Construction Representatives will provide support to aid the Contractor's and Subcontractor's supervisors and foremen in an effective safety and loss prevention program. In the event the Company's Safety and/or Construction Representative observes
