The plaintiff in this action against Monsanto is or was an employe of our customer, Hexagon Laboratories. Hexagon has a plant in Bronx, New York. Kamer in his petition alleges toxic hepatitis as a result of being exposed to Aroclor fumes. In addition, he alleges that Aroclor is advertised as being non-toxic whereas in reality it is toxic.
