

Q No, sir. Getting back to the question as to why the word "cancer" or "danger" didn't appear in here, isn't it true that industry thought people would stop buying these asbestos brakes?

A That may very well be. I think some members felt that way.

Q Do you remember who they were?

A No, I do not.

Q Now getting back to that 1977 recommended procedure that doesn't mention cancer, do you think that reflected the full knowledge of the FMSI in 1977?

A I believe so.

Q Okay. Now let's look at what Mr. Weaver said in that address he gave to the membership back in 1973 in the summertime out at Vail. We talked about that earlier. You have that in front of you. That's Plaintiff's Exhibit 3. Didn't Mr. Weaver say that all major commercial types of asbestos can cause cancer?

A I believe he said that, but I don't think he said it at what level and all that. In other words, I'm saying you can cause cancer, but if you had a certain level, it might be 0.1 fibers per
