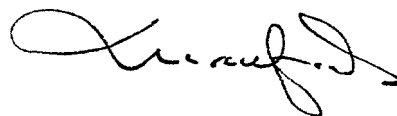

We have been using Dr. Bessman's method for lead analysis since the beginning of our lead work. The reason that this antedates the publication of this paper is that Dr. Bessman happened to be here in this hospital at that time. This method is unquestionably faster and less subject to error than any of the previous methods. I doubt very much that we could have undertaken the lead project on its present scale without this method.
