NOTES TO SCHEDULE I (b) - INVESTMENTS IN SECURITIES OF SUBSIDIARIES

- NOTE 1 - Anaconda Lead Products Company at December 31st 1935 was 89.01% owned by registrant. In the year 1934 1,500 shares were acquired for \$80,000 increasing the holding of registrant to 100%. The stock of Anaconda Lead Products Company representing a total investment of \$1,395,000 was transferred to International Smelting Refining Company, a wholly owned subsidiary, in exchange for 13,500 shares of stock of that company having a value of \$1,012,500. Anaconda Lead Products Company was then dissolved and its assets transferred to International Smelting and Refining Company. (See Surplus Account, schedule IX (b)).
- NOTE 2 - On October 7th 1934 Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) a wholly owned subsidiary of registrant, was dissolved. Included in the assets of Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) were 519,515 shares of stock of Andes Copper Mining Company. These shares were carried on the books of that company at the original par value, \$25.00 per share. (See general Consolidated Balance Sheet note 1 Surplus). On dissolution of Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) said 519,515 shares of stock of Andes Copper Mining Company were transferred to registrant. Registrant included this stock in its accounts at \$1,331,250.00, the original investment in Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) and the difference between the original par value of the stock, \$12,982,875, and \$1,331,250. (Investment of registrant has been applied as a reduction to the consolidated surplus appearing on the balance sheet of registrant and 100% owned subsidiaries. (See Surplus Account, schedule IX (b)).
- NOTE 3 - Includes \$8,775.80 for investment determined to be worthless in 1934.
- NOTE 4 - In addition to amount shown there is still unpaid on subscription to 200,000 shares a sum of \$2,203,172.74.
- NOTE 5 - Amount transferred to stock of Andes Copper Mining Company being advances to Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) now dissolved, the sole asset of which was stock of Andes Copper Mining Company.
- NOTE 6 - All other subsidiaries not consolidated are not significant in respect to (1) the assets they represent and (2) the sales or operating revenues of such non-consolidated subsidiaries.
- NOTE 7 - Basis of investment is set forth in note H to general Consolidated Balance Sheet of registrant and 100% owned subsidiaries.

NOTES TO SCHEDULE I (c) - INVESTMENTS IN SECURITIES OF SUBSIDI

NOTE 1 - On October 7th 1936 Andes Exploration Company (Delaware a wholly owned subsidiary of registrant, was dissolved. Included in the assets of Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) were 519,315 shares of stock of Andes Copper Mining Company. These shares were carried on the books of that company at the original par value, \$25.00 per share. (See general Consolidated Balance Sheet note 1 Surplus). On dissolution of Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) said 519,315 shares of stock of Andes Copper Mining Company were transferred to registrant. Registrant included this stock in its accounts at \$1,331,250.00, the original investment in Andes Exploration Company (Delaware) and the difference between the original par value of a stock, \$12,982,875. and \$1,331,250. (investment of registrant) has been applied as a reduction to the consolidated surplus appearing on the balance sheet of registrant a 100% owned subsidiaries. (See Surplus Account, schedule IX (b)).

NOTE 2 - Butte Electric Railway Company was dissolved in the year 1934 and its assets transferred to registrant.

NOTE 3 - Anaconda Lead Products Company at December 31st 1935 was 89.01% owned by registrant. In the year 1936 1,500 shares were acquired for \$80,000, increasing the holdings of registrant to 100%. The stock of Anaconda Lead Products Company representing a total investment of \$1,395,000. was transferred to International Smelting and Refining Company, a wholly owned subsidiary, in exchange for 13,500 shares of stock of that Company having a par value of \$1,012,500. Anaconda Lead Products Company was then dissolved and its assets transferred to International Smelting and Refining Company. (See Schedules IX (a) and IX (b)).

NOTE 4 - Sales of stock of two subsidiaries of registrant to other subsidiaries.

NOTE 5 - Includes \$8,773.80 for investment determined to be worthless in 1934.

NOTE 6 - All other subsidiaries not listed separately are not significant in respect to (1) the assets they represent and (2) the sales or operating revenues of such subsidiaries.

NOTE 7 - Basis of investment is set forth in note F to Balance Sheet of registrant only.
