Shell has reviewed the 1998 refining capacity numbers. The following adjustments need to be made:

Shell no longer owns the following refineries: Wood River, IL; Odessa, TX; Anacortes, WA.

Texaco, with whom Shell has a joint venture, no longer owns the El Dorado, KS refinery.

After making adjustments for refineries that we no longer own and calculating the percentage ownership in the Shell/Texaco joint venture, the Shell US refining capacity is 650,000.

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
