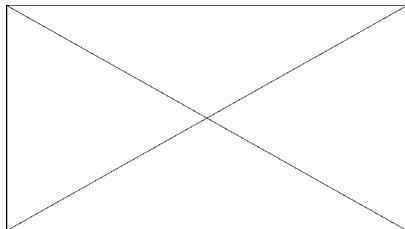
Brooke,
