I am inclosing herewith copy of report entitled "Public Health Reports". This issue contains the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company's study of "Effects Of The Inhalation Of Asbestos Dust On The Lungs Of Asbestos Workers".

If you will refer to Page 4, you will notice it lists Plants A, B, C, D and E. "B" is Charleston, "C" is Mannheim and "D" is Bridgeport and Stratford. We believe "A" is Johns-Manville and "E" is Russell, though we are not certain.

This information is taken from a study made during the period of October 1923 to January 1931, and of course, conditions have changed somewhat since that time.
