NOTIFICATION OF PENALTY ASSESSMENT

This notification of the penalty(ies) assessed by the Director of the Department of Labor and Industries, or his authorized representative, shall be deemed to be the final order of the Department and not subject to review or any kind of agency appeal. Within 15 working days from the communication of this notification, you submit a NOTICE OF APPEAL. The NOTICE OF APPEAL should be mailed or otherwise delivered to the Assistant Director, Industrial Safety and Health at the address shown at the top of this notification. If no NOTICE OF APPEAL is filed within the 15 working day period, the proposed penalty(ies) become final and is immediately payable. (RCW 49.17.140) The term "working day" means a calendar day, except Saturdays, Sundays and all other holidays as set forth in RCW 49.16.050 (RCW 49.17.140).

Payment of all penalties shown is to be made by check or money order payable to the order of Department of Labor and Industries. Payment of penalties should be remitted to the Assistant Director of Industrial Safety and Health at the address shown above.

Section 14(b) of the Act (RCW 49.17.140) states: "Civil penalties imposed under this chapter shall be paid to the Director for deposit in the supplemental pension fund established by RCW 51.48.031. Civil penalties may be recovered in a civil action in the case of the department brought in the superior court of the county where the violation is alleged to have occurred, or the Department may utilize the procedures for collection of civil penalties as set forth in RCW 51.48.120 through 51.48.150."
