6 BY MR. RUCKDESCHEL:

7 Q Regarding exposure are the opinions you have
8 related to exposure and exposure levels expressed in
9 your 2003 paper?

10 MR. LANKFORD: Objection to form.

11 THE WITNESS: Well, in a general -- I'm sorry.

12 MR. LANKFORD: And specifically are you asking
13 opinions overall, in this case?

14 BY MR. RUCKDESCHEL:

15 Q I'm asking him about his opinions regarding
16 exposure of brake mechanics to asbestos dust and
17 whether those opinions are set forth in his 2003 paper,
18 just as I asked it.

19 A I don't think the question is answerable as
20 presented because it's so broad. If you're asking me
21 can I apply that data to every single person that files
22 a claim and for which I give an opinion, the answer is
23 no.

24 If you want to know do I think that represents
25 the vast majority of persons normally employed as brake
