#### "THE AMERICAN WAY"

The Penney speech pointed out that not only material things but those of a spiritual and cultural nature are comprised in "the American way of life," that all kinds of people are enabled to enjoy opportunities for individual development up to the limit of their own capacities; that basic factors are the home, the church, the school and the legislative body, to gether with freedom of enterprise.

"The American way is the best economic system yet developed in all the history of the world," Penney declared, "and there is no adequate substitute for the free enterprise system—although it is under fire and some are planning its

overthrow. There is no question of their sincerity—but they are misinformed and misguided." In conclusion the address condemned the Wagner-Murray-Dingle Bill for compulsory national medical service as a "Utopian scheme, a plan to plunge the country into a totalitarian economy," although the American system of medicine is the best in the world, and one of the wonders of the last world war.

Widely divergent views were expressed by the panel members who spoke following the Penney address, leading to a stimulating discussion of the main points at issue.
