Technical advances, widely influencing the entire outlook for the production and use of industrial power, will be featured at the 17th National Exposition of Power and Mechanical Engineering. Returning once more to its traditional site in Grand Central Palace, The Exposition will be held coincident with the annual meeting of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers.

DURING a history of almost 25 years, the National Exposition of Power and Mechanical Engineering has become a strong institution, unique in a number of respects. Established shortly after the first World War, it then satisfied, and continues to fulfill a well recognized purpose in joining the general interests of consumers of power and producers of power generating equipment. The exceptional facts associated with the Exposition are that it provides a forum for the exchange of technical and engineering information concerning power problems, as well as a display of the most recent advances in methods and equipment.

Threefold Influence

The influence of the Exposition is threefold. Foremost and most obvious is its directly productive value in the visual simplification of questions concerning the composition, modification, and maintenance of power plants and the dis-

tribution and use of power. In this aspect, it is a working demonstration-display of special engineering equipment, having a substantial merchandising flavor.

The second potential of the Exposition is the aid rendered to the formation of projections and plans, often running several years ahead of realization on new plants, reorganizations, and betterments. It is, above all, an exposition for industrial planners, including all projects which convert energy or apply power directly.

Third, and in some ways most influential, is the value of the Exposition as an educational medium, for it serves visitors, almost without exception, as an institution where specialists are enabled to discuss the work of specialists outside their own, often narrow fields; and inspect the fruits of their undertakings.

Forum for Engineers

Progress in methods, practice, and equipment design, as revealed

by the exhibits, promise a considerably greater advance all along the line than has often been noted at these biennial displays because of the dual influence of innovations in war production and also the partial suspense of commercial animation during the past decade. Many products at the Power Show will be entirely new, others are revised to incorporate an improved selection of materials. New methods of manufacture have also encouraged design changes from the motive of economy in a good many instances.

The Exposition, as in past years, is primarily a forum for the manufacturers and users of power plant equipment—fuel handling; combustion; the distribution, economizing; and utilization of heat; auxiliaries; measuring and recording instruments; controls, and even applications of power in a number of classes of machinery, especially that intended for the construction, upkeep, and overhauling of power plants.
