RESTRICTED AREA- Rope off area

Post warning signs

Remove portable objects

Cover adjacent structures

Cover underneath work

REMOVAL-

Wet asbestos (amended H2O)

Handle carefully

Place in approved bags

Encapsulate terminations

Clean surface

Cleanup and decontaminate

Dispose of promptly

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ASBESTOS
HANDLING PROCEDURES
(GASKETS AND PACKINGS)

STORAGE- Clean area regularly (HEPA VAC)

REMOVAL- If not adhered-remove and dispose
 of properly.

 If mechanical means are used: —

 Wear proper protective equip.

 Use tools equipped with vacuum.

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ASBESTOS DO'S

DO get positive identification

DO take sufficient samples

DO consult guidelines if it's asbestos

DO put all asbestos waste in approved containers

DO inform all personnel in general area of asbestos
work in progress

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ASBESTOS DON'TS

DON'T use ACMs where adequate substitutes exist.

DON'T use asbestos bags for general trash

DON'T sandblast or hydroblast ACMs

DON'T use compressed air on ACMs

DON'T dry sweep ACMs

DON'T spray ACMs

DON'T use an ordinary vacuum cleaner

DON'T remove ceiling tiles below ACMs without
taking proper precautions
