4 THE COURT: It has never left this
5 courtroom.

6 MS. TOSTANOSKI: Your Honor, it was put in
7 evidence in Judge Levin's courtroom.

8 THE COURT: Is there another one?

9 MR. IGNATOWSKI: It is my understanding that
10 we had gotten permission to have this vial, I believe,
11 removed and -- from the evidence in the previous trial
12 and used in this, but I will check that to be sure.

13 THE COURT: It was my understanding that
14 that was the case.

15 MR. IGNATOWSKI: Yes. That is my
16 understanding.

17 THE COURT: That is why it has stayed in
18 here pending any request by the Appellate Court for
19 that vial.
