Six short term asbestos samples were taken by St. Louis personnel and submitted to EED for counting. The results are summarized below:

Sample Identification	Time (min)	Fibers/cc
SL-1 #5 Trimming Machine Operator	30	0.9
SL-2 Handyman	60	0.5
SL-3 #3 Lincoln Saw Operator	50	5.0
SL-4 #3 Assistant Lincoln Saw Operator	50	2.3
SL-5 Raw Material-High Lift Operator	45	0.9
SL-6 Raw Material Unloader	45	1.2

These short term samples were taken by St. Louis personnel in order to determine the magnitude of exposure of several job classifications during specific duties. These results indicate that the jobs represented by SL-3, 4, 5 and 6 should all be sampled for 15 minutes in order to determine peak ceiling exposure.
