Gentlemen:

Enclosed is a copy of the stenotyped report of the Tuesday morning session of the joint meeting of the Lead Industries Association and the Zinc Institute held on April 6, 1971 at the Drake Hotel in Chicago.

Beginning on page 11 is the talk by Dr. Vaun Newill of the EPA. Also enclosed are copies of Dr. Newill's slides in proper order relating to his talk.
